Kaiser Library opened as a storefront library in May of 2002. The library focused on computers with internet capabilities and reading materials for an extensive spectrum of ages. Circulating over 171,000 items in 2005, it has grown to become a community recognized and successful organization. The mission of Kaiser Library is to “provide service that is high in quality and timeliness while promoting the joy of reading, research, literacy and access to information for people of all ages.” To accomplish their goals of achieving this atmosphere, Kaiser Library created an imaginative and comfortable floor design that was completed with the installation of ECOsurfaces Commercial Flooring.



ECOsurfaces delivered intricate and vivid designs to Kaiser Library in the form of bold color combinations and detailed inlays. Predominantly, hues of red, tan, and dark gray/brown were implemented in pinwheel patterns made of water jet cuts. In addition, dragonfly silhouettes were inlayed in various positions throughout the space to assist in the promotion of an energetic and playful atmosphere. While achieving detailed design qualifications, Kaiser Library was equipped with the high durability, quality, and environmental sustainability of ECOsurfaces.
