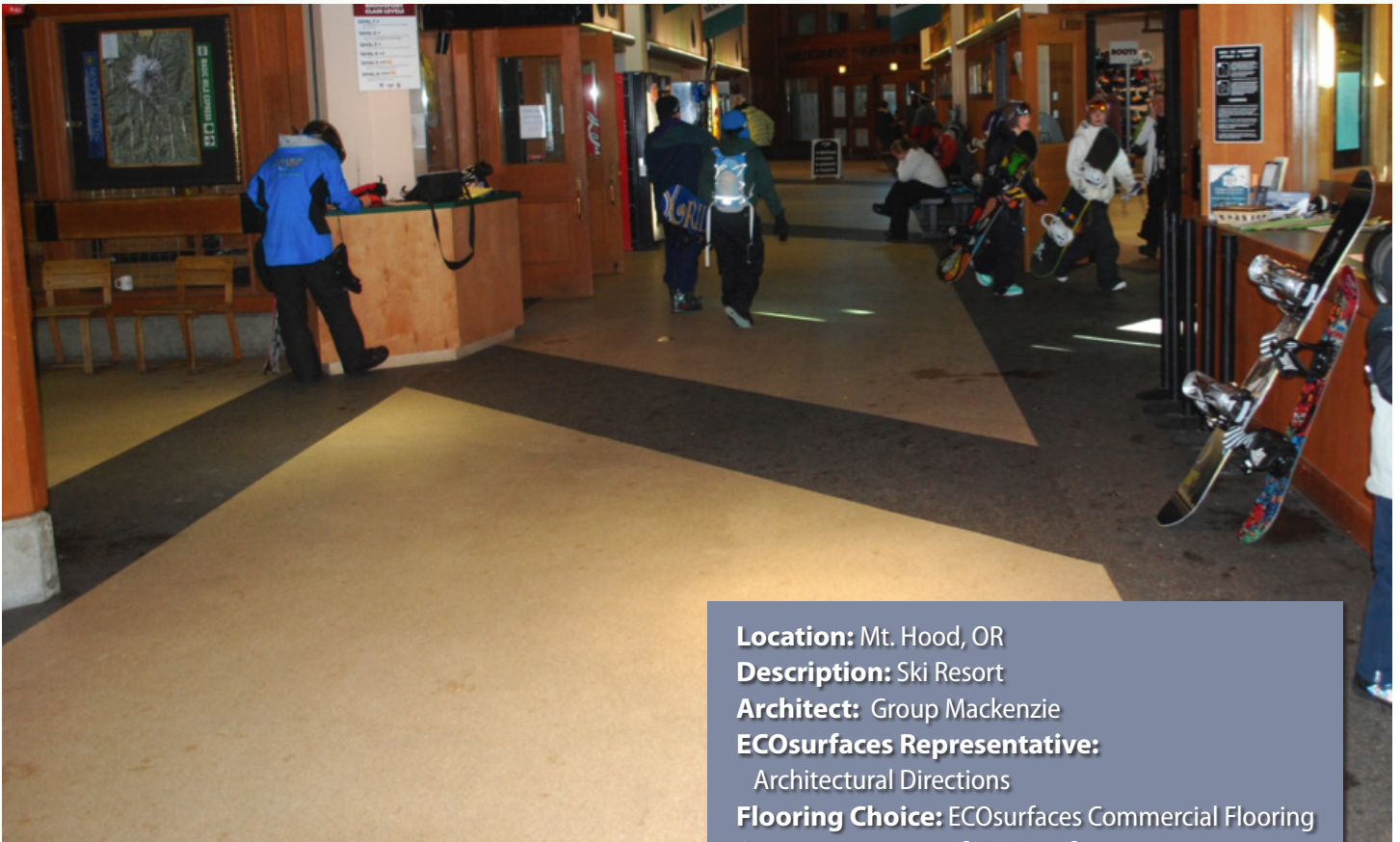

Timberline Lodge, located an hour east of Portland, Oregon, can be found nestled on majestic Mount Hood. The resort, with its 41 trails and 6,000 foot elevation, has become a destination for skiers and adventurers in the winter and world class snow-sport athletic training during the summer. Wy'East Day Lodge, the center of ski operations for Timberline Lodge Resort, offers a cozy lounge, rental shop, ski school, lockers, gift shop, and restaurant.

When selecting over 90% of the flooring in Wy'East Day Lodge the environment was essential. This concern for the environment and air quality was even more important at an elevation of 6,000 feet, where the air is already thin. "If an architect doesn't see FloorScore on the binder, they won't even pull it off the shelf," says Art Stevenson of Architectural Directions. Luckily, ECOsurfaces Commercial Flooring is FloorScore Certified and can help contribute toward up to 12 LEED points, depending on the project.
